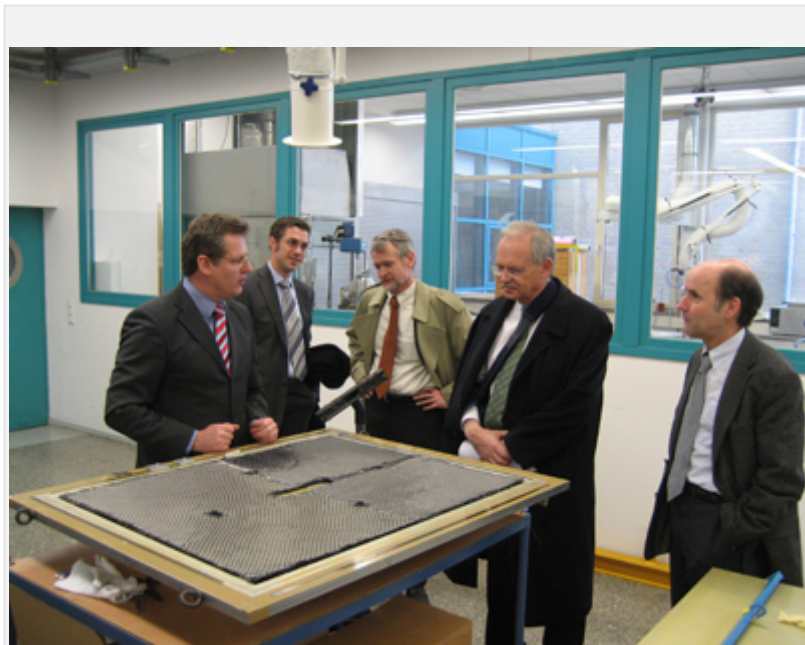

The guest from Berlin informed himself about efficiency gains through strategic control of the processes at the airports' close-up-range, the areas of application of adaptronics and carbon fiber reinforced plastic materials as well as the use of numerical simulation for aircraft development.

Schrick was very impressed by DLR's system competence in the field of aeronautics, the wide range of research fields covered and the amount of cooperation with industry partners.
